The **Craft group** had a wonderful afternoon weaving swallows from willow. 18 members listened to Robyn from Nature Makers tell us of the buying of the willow from Somerset and the soaking of it for a few days to make it supple enough to use.

We all started with a 2 metre length of willow and made the basic body shape of a bird. Admittedly some looked thin and some fat but then we began to weave the body using the basic shape and we gradually pulled it into



shape. We did find that the more we worked the willow with our fingers the easier it was to bend.



With a break for tea and cake. (thank you to Joan our tea maker of the afternoon) we then added the wings. All 18 members were so thrilled to have had the opportunity to try a new traditional craft and go home with a

completed swallow ready to hang, preferably outside to keep moist and last for many seasons to come.

Baking Beauties challenged themselves to bake using gelatine. Panna cotta, mandarin cheesecake, a full on 'Cheese cake' and marshmallow dusted in dried raspberries all fit the bill.





The star of the afternoon was Pat with her white chocolate panna cotta and fruit jelly combination made in her Bundt tin. It looked stunning and tasted delicious - Star Baker Pat!
